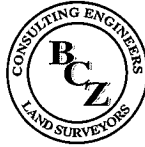

NOTE: Wherein this Addendum conflicts with the "Plans and Specifications", dated August 1, 2009, this Addendum shall govern.

PLANS:

1. **Sheets 2 of 4** – Revised Summary of Quantities in accordance with enclosed revised BID FORM.
2. **Sheet 2 or 4** – Add the following General Note: "Existing pumps shall remain the property of the Owner."
3. **Sheet 5** — Change the drawings on the right side of the sheet to Detail 2/5.
4. **Sheet 5** – Details 1/5 and 2/5 – Change the elevation of the top of the wet well to 657.0.

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. **Section 00410** – Replace the entire section with the new one that is enclosed.
2. **Section 11500, 2.01** – Add the following:
 - B. **Alternate:**
 1. Hydromatic Pumps may be bid as an Alternate.
 2. The pumps shall meet essentially the requirements listed above.

- Class 1, Division 1, Group D explosion-proof service.
 - Pass a 3" diameter sphere.
 - L.S. #1: 320 GPM @ 33' T.D.H.
230 volt, 1 Phase.
 - L.S. #3: 180 GPM @ 52' T.D.H.
230 volt, 3 Phase.
3. Any additional cost to comply with Section 11500 shall be the contractor's responsibility.
3. **Section 02207** – Delete 1.03.
4. **Section 02637** – Delete 3.06.
5. **Section 02640** – Delete 2.01, 2.04 and Part 3.

NOTE: Bidders shall note in writing on the Bid Form that this Addendum has been taken into consideration, identifying same as Addendum No. 3, dated January 13, 2010.

3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.

- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the Site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in SC-4.02, and (2) reports and drawings of Hazardous Environmental Conditions that have been identified in SC-4.06.
- E. Bidder has obtained and carefully studied (or accepts the consequences for not doing so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by Bidder, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.
- F. Bidder does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.
- I. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- J. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
- K. Bidder will submit written evidence of its authority to do business in the state where the Project is located not later than the date of its execution of the Agreement.

ARTICLE 4 – FURTHER REPRESENTATIONS

4.01 Bidder further represents that:

- A. this Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation;

- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over Owner.
