Sealed Bids for the construction of the ALL-WEATHER TRACK & FIELD FACILITY are invited and will be received by COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 3 (hereinafter referred to as Owner) at SUPERINTENDENT'S OFFICE, 2110 HWY 94 NORTH, CAMP POINT, ILLINOIS 62320 on or before, but no later than 2:00 P.M., June 14, 2010 and immediately thereafter all Bids received will be publicly opened.

Sealed envelopes or packages containing Bids shall be marked or endorsed "BID FOR ALL-WEATHER TRACK & FIELD FACILITY." No Bid will be considered unless it is made on the bid form which is included in the Project Manual.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The above designated work and improvements referred to as ALL-WEATHER TRACK & FIELD FACILITY, on which Bids are requested will include the following construction:

The furnishing of all labor, materials, and equipment for the complete construction of an All-Weather Track. All work shall be performed in accordance with and as indicated on the Contract Drawings and Project Manual. The owner will provide a site complete with a drainage system and prepared subgrade ready to construct the all-weather track from the subgrade to the all-weather surface.

PREBID CONFERENCE

A mandatory prebid conference will be held at JOB SITE, 2110 HWY 94 NORTH, CAMP POINT, ILLINOIS AT 2:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY JUNE 9, 2010. Representatives of the Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. Engineer will transmit to all prospective Bidders such Addenda as Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the prebid conference.

BID SECURITY

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the order of the Owner, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the Bidder and a surety company, in an amount not less than five percent of Bidder's maximum Bid price as a guarantee that the Bidder will within fifteen (15) days after the date of the award of a contract execute an Agreement and file bonds and insurance as required by the Bidding Documents if his Bid is accepted.

If the Successful Bidder fails to execute and file an Agreement, bonds and insurance as required by the Bidding Documents, the amount of the security submitted with his Bid shall be forfeited.

HOLDING OF BIDS

No Bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the Bids without the consent of the Owner, for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of closing Bids.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

The Owner reserves the right to reject any Bid for failure to comply with all requirements of this notice or any of the Bidding Documents; however, it may waive any minor defects or informalities at its discretion. The Owner further reserves the right to reject any and all Bids or to award a contract which in its judgment is in the best interest of the Owner.
